

Monumental Inscriptions
from
The Rehoboth Baptist Chapel
New Street, Horsham,
Sussex.

The Rehoboth Baptist Chapel was founded in May 1834 by six persons hitherto associated with the church of which Mr. John Harm was pastor (a Mr. John Harm was then pastor of the Congregational Church, Horsham).

The chapel was erected by Mr. Fugwell and came into use during October 1834.

The monumental inscriptions were recorded by Mr. P. J. Cox for The Sussex Family History Group and Horsham Museum Society during 1981. It is hoped that a full archaeological and photographic survey will be undertaken by members of the Horsham Museum Society in the near future.

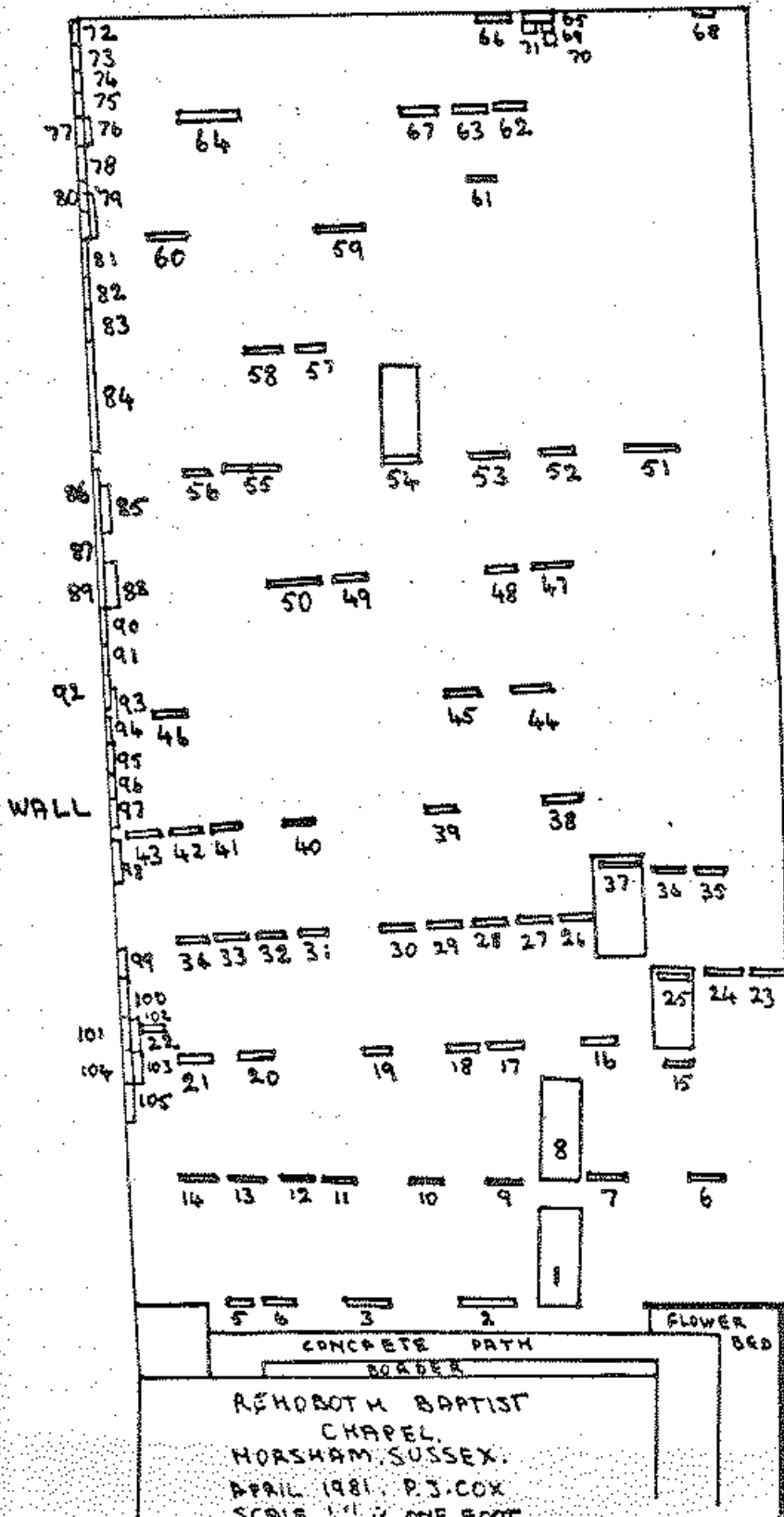
